


Population Change






Change in Poverty Rate 2000-2015








Percent Households in Poverty






Poverty Rate Change Age 0-17




Poverty Rate Change Age






Poverty Rate Change Age5-17












Average Commute Time (mins)






Percent Population with No High School Diploma






Residential Vacancy Rate

Residential Vacancies, Percent by Tract, HUD 2016-Q4














